How to Book

For children currently attending a YMCA Childcare OSHC Service:

- Complete a current Vacation Care Booking Form, available from our website: oshc.ymcansw.org.au
- Scan and email the completed booking form to oshc.homebush@ymcansw.org.au or hand to the service coordinator.
- The administration team will calculate the payable fee as soon as possible and contact you to confirm your booking.

For children who DO NOT currently attend a YMCA Childcare OSHC Service:

- Complete a 2015 Enrolment Form and a current Vacation Care Booking Form. These are available from the YMCA OSHC website oshc.ymcansw.org.au
- Scan and email the completed booking form to oshc.homebush@ymcansw.org.au or hand to the service coordinator.
- The administration team will calculate the payable fee, as soon as possible and contact you to confirm your booking.

Payment Method

Please supply credit card details. Bookings will not be processed without FULL PAYMENT prior to attendance or with any outstanding fees from a previous holiday period and/or Before and After School Care.

Important Information

Family Assistance

YMCA offers discounted fees to children who are registered with the Family Assistance Office. Phone 136 150 or visit http://www.familyassist.gov.au. To obtain CCB, children must be 5 years of age and/or attending school.

Refunds

Refunds are only available if the YMCA cancels a program.

Immunisation

All children will be accepted into the Vacation Care Program; however children who have not been immunised will be excluded from the program in the event of an outbreak of an infectious disease. Families must provide evidence of immunisation or have an exemption to be eligible for the CCB allowance.

Please indicate immunisation status in the space provided on the Enrolment Form.

Excursions, Clinics and Incursion Activities

Children must arrive at least 20 minutes prior to departure for all YMCA Vacation Care excursions and clinics to ensure that programs run to schedule. Information regarding departure times or special requirements, please refer to the booking form activities information section. Any changes to the program will be informed via direct contact from the centre. Excursion risk assessments are available for review at the centre or at oshc.ymcansw.org.au. Children attending excursions must wear an excursion T-Shirt. Children that do not have a YMCA T-shirt will be not be able to leave the premises. Children attending all YMCA Vacation Care programs must wear a broadbrimmed hat and enclosed shoes.

Arrival and Departures

At the commencement of each day, parents must sign their child/ren into the Day Camp, Excursion or Clinic that they are attending. Children must also be signed out and will not be allowed to leave the Centre with any person other than those nominated on the Enrolment Form.

Late Fees

The penalty fee for collecting a child after the specified closing time is \$20 per 15 minute increments per child to provide sufficient funds to pay additional wages for two educators for time worked. Late fees must be paid in full. They do not attract CCB. Please refer to the Parent Handbook for more information. This can be obtained at our centre or downloaded at oshc.ymcansw.org.au.

You should arrive with sufficient time to have a discussion with staff about your child, collect your child and their belongings and be out the door of the service before the specified closing time. The time used for the calculation of the late fee is not the time of your arrival, but the time of departure after collecting your child and conducting any other business.

Breach of YMCA Policies and Procedures

YMCA Policies and Procedures are established for the safety and enjoyment of all children. Breaches of these policies and procedures may result in exclusions from activities or the program following consultation between parents/families and YMCA management.


