




### **Group School Photos**

### Kindergarten 2017

Please enrol for Kindergarten 2017 now. Children born between 1st August 2011 and 31st July 2012 are eligible to enrol. Parents / carers who would like to enrol a child for Kindergarten next year, need to visit the school office. Please bring the following;

- Proof of student's residential address (E.g. original copies of council rates, electricity accounts etc.)
- Birth certificate or identity documents
- **Proof of Australian Citizenship** (E.g. Citizenship paper, Australian passport, overseas passport with visa)
- Immunisation History Statement (Only required if enrolling for first time in primary school)
- Copies of any family law or other relevant court orders (if applicable)
- Health care plan, Asthma plan, Allergy plan and Anaphylaxis plan (Can be obtained in consultation with family doctor)

It was a beautiful sunny day and the girls where very confident. We got off to a great start with HWPS scoring 6 home runs in the first inning and 7 in the second.


The Junior Girls did a tremendous job, winning 20 -7. They kept their motivation and showed wonderful sportsmanship throughout the game.






