Both our current councillors are **willing to stand for the role again** which means **no nominations are required**. However, if you do wish to nominate alterative representatives please contact the office for a nomination form.

What Should I do if there is a problem for my child at school?

- Make an appointment to see the class teacher. Allow time (one week) for the teacher to work your child and any other child to resolve the problem at school.
- Let the teacher know if the problem continues and let the teacher try again to solve the problem.
- If the problem continues you should make an appointment to see the supervisor of your child's year group, the Assistant Principal.
- If you are still not satisfied with the process or resolution make an appointment to see the Deputy Principal/Principal.
- In the case of serious incidents, where there is a risk of significant harm, contact the office to seek an urgent appointment with the Deputy Principal/Principal.
- The Principal will be the final point of contact, except in cases where there is a significant risk of harm, or highly sensitive issue.
 - ✓ It is appropriate for parents to inform the school.
 - It is not appropriate to approach other children and or their parents.



Enrolments for Kindergarten 2018 are now being finalised.

Children born between 1st August 2012 and 31st July 2013 are eligible to enrol. Parents / carers who would like to enrol a child for Kindergarten next year, need to visit the school office. Please bring the following;

- Child's birth certificate for proof of age
- Passports and visas for families born overseas
- Proof of residence (e.g. Council rate notice, gas, rental agreement, electricity account or bank account). We do not accept driver's licences.
- Immunisation Certificate
- Health Plans were required (allergy, asthma etc)
