#### Parking; Kiss and Ride Zones

Parking around our school is difficult. The answers to the parking challenges that most schools face include; *arriving early or plan to park further away and then walk*. To avoid costly fines, please pay close attention to the parking signs and conditions around our school. The council ranger and police highway patrol are monitoring drivers closely.

Please be aware that **there is only ONE accessible 'kiss and ride' zone** at our school located on Exeter Road. This zone operates under the same conditions as 'no parking' zones.

Kiss and ride zones require parents to **remain within 3 meters of their vehicle and you cannot remain in a 'kiss and ride zone' for longer than 2mins**. The penalty and fines for disobeying a 'kiss and ride' sign are 2 demerit points and approximately \$250 fine.

#### Students returning to school after surgery or an injury

This is a reminder to parents and carers about our school's procedure for students returning to school after surgery, an injury or an extended illness. The purpose of following the below guidelines ensures that the school, and particularly their class teachers, have all the necessary information in order to minimise further risk of harm to the injured/recovering student.

Please be aware of the following;

- A 'return to school' meeting is required with the Deputy Principal before the student can return to class. This can be arranged through the school office.
- Parents are required to bring written documentation from their GP or medical specialist confirming they are fit to return to school.
- If the student requires modifications to their learning environment and or programs, these will need to be specified by the GP or medical specialist and a 'Health Care Plan' will be drafted by the Deputy Principal in consultation with parents
- The 'Health Care Plan' is then communicated to appropriate staff members to ensure effective risk management

#### **Uniform Reminder**

The school community is committed to maintaining a strong uniform policy. A strong uniform policy supports our student wellbeing and discipline policies and anti-bullying strategies. Currently there is a large proportion of students who are not wearing a full school uniform. Please be aware, <u>coloured school bags have been phased out</u>.



All students are expected to own a **Homebush West School Bag**, see image right. These bags are **ergonomically designed** for the purpose of school, for example to carry resources safely and they can be adjusted as students grow. They are comfortable, they're made of excellent quality and have a lifetime warranty. These can be ordered through the online uniform shop on the Homebush West Public School's website.


