Creative and Performing Arts Excellence

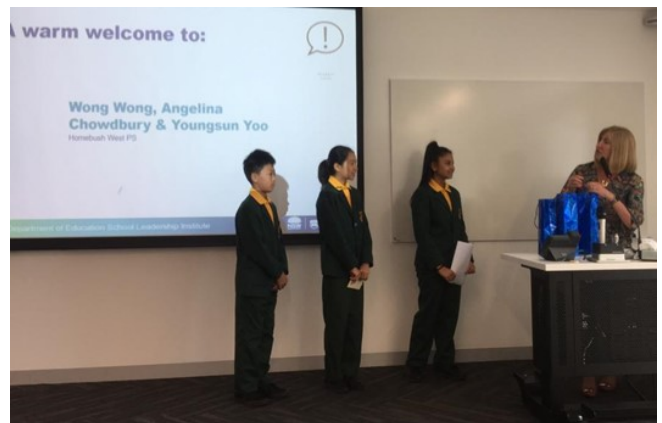

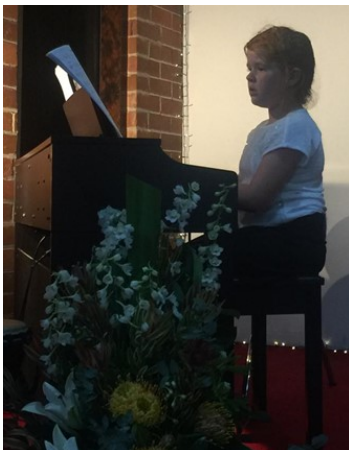

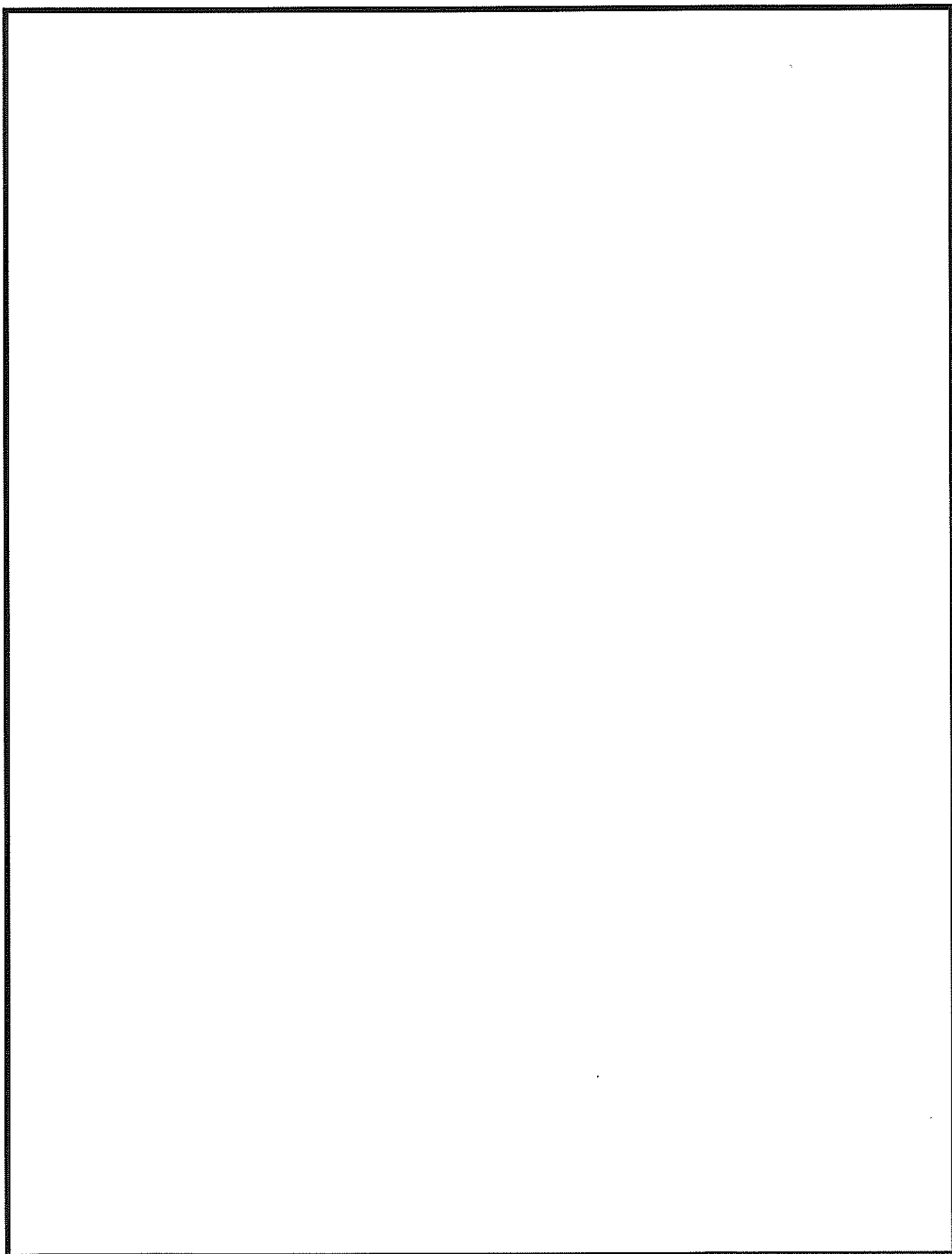
